Our exceptional music ministry touches every single person who attends our worship services; let us continue to sing, "All Are Welcome".

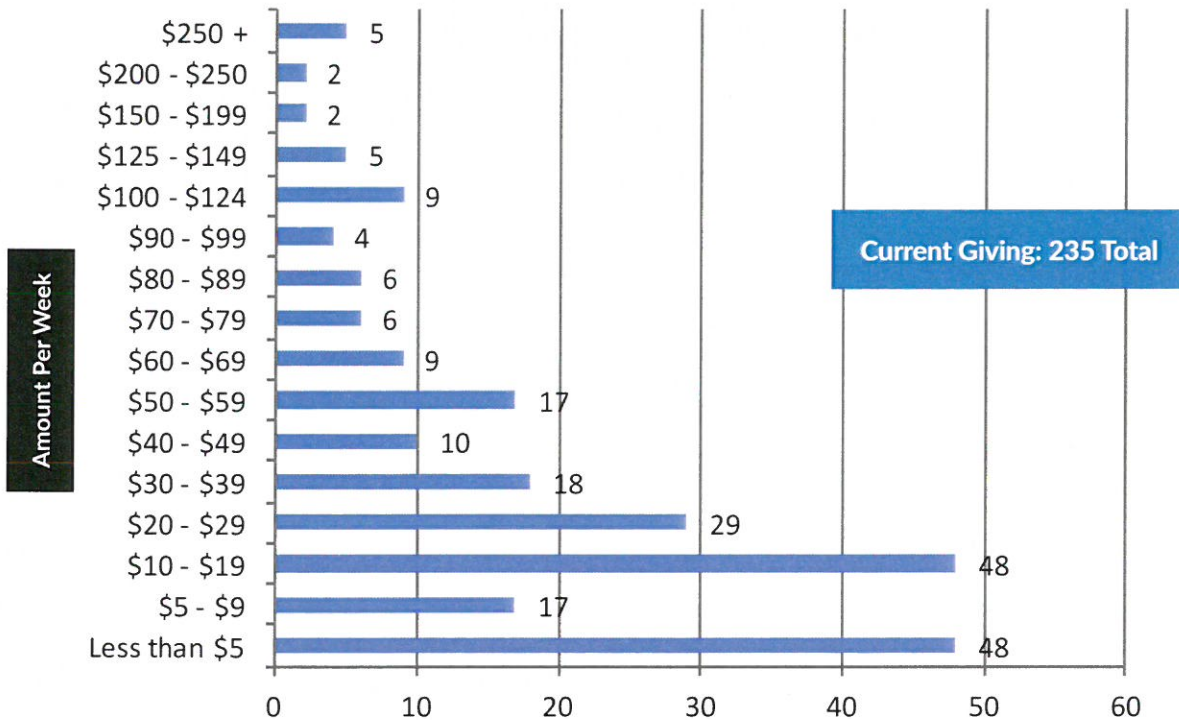
