More joyful voices, more frequent instrumental ensembles, more children's opportunities to participate and even more can be available with your support of this initiative.

Have you ever seen our youth off to Rainbow Trail or our members heading down the hill to serve with Christ's Body Ministry (CBM)? A long string of cars have to make the trip. The **eVANGELISM Outreach** initiative (the purchase or lease of a van) will eliminate wasting the time and resources of those serving and present less risk for everyone.

The van will be available to all ELC groups – CBM, "Workshop" Sunday, tED, Sunday School, the Lunch Bunch, etc.

The **Virtual Worship and Ministry Outreach** initiative will move ELC into the on-line technological arena where non-members and members alike can view our services, participate in Adult Faith forums, etc. It will be an especially welcome resource for those members who are home bound for a time because of illness or infirmity.

An added benefit is that it is a new way to reach a greater audience outside of our membership and let them see what ELC offers.

Funding **Continuing Ministry Support** will allow ELC to insure all the excellences in our ministry that we are accustomed to.
